**NOTE "1"** 

### (1) ACCOUNTING POLICIES & NOTES ON ACCOUNT:

(1.1) Basis of Accounting

- (a) The financial statement have been prepared on accrual basis and under the historical cost convention and in compliance in all material aspects, with the applicable accounting standards notified under 211(3)(C) and the other relevant provision of the Companies Act, 1956.
- (b) All assets and liabilities have been classified as current or non current as per the Company's normal operating cycle and other criteria set out in schedule VI (Revised) to the Companies Act, 1956. Based on the nature of business the time of their realization in cash & cash equivalents, the company has ascertained its operating cycle as twelve months for the purpose of current & non current classification of liabilities.

(1.2) Tangible Fixed Assets:

Tangible Fixed Assets are stated at Cost of acquisition and subsequent improvements thereto including Taxes, Duties, freight and other expenses incidental to acquisition and installation of fixed assets. In case of revaluation of fixed assets, the cost as ascertained by the valuer is considered in the accounts and differential amount is credited to Revaluation Reserve.

(1.3) Inventories:

Stock in Trade is valued script wise at cost or market price whichever is lower.

- (1.4) <u>Employee Benefits:</u>
  No provision of gratuity liability is made in the books as the Gratuity Act is not applicable to our company.
- (1.5) Depreciation:

  Depreciation on fixed assets has been provided on written down value method at the rates and in the manner specified in Schedule XIV to the Companies Act, 1956.
- (1.6) Investments:

  Long term investments are carried at Cost after deducting provision, if any, for diminution in value considered being other than temporary nature.
- (1.7) Taxation:
  Provision for current tax is made in accordance with the provisions of the Income tax Act, 1961. Deferred tax liabilities and assets are recognized at substantively enacted tax rates, subject to the consideration of prudence, on timing difference, being the difference between taxable income and accounting income that originate in one period and are capable of reversal in one or more subsequent periods.
- (1.8) Revenue Recognition : Income on sale of investment is recognized on the date of contract note issued by the broker. Interest income is accounted on accrual basis. Dividend Income is accounted when right to receive payment is established.
- (1.9) Contingent Liabilities:

  No provision is made for liabilities, which are of contingent in nature, but if material, these are disclosed by way of notes.
- (1.10) Revaluation Reserve:
  It represents the notional increase in the value of fixed assets belonging to the company in terms of the valuer's report. Depreciation was applied on revalued amount & the same has been adjusted with the Revaluation Reserve.

(1.11) Earning per share:

Basic earning per share is computed by dividing the profit/(loss) after tax( including the post tax effect of extraordinary items, if any) by the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year. Diluted earning per share is computed by dividing the profit/(loss) after tax (including the post tax effect of extraordinary items, if any) as adjusted for dividend, interest and other charges to expense relating to the dilutive potential equity shares, by the weighted average number of equity shares considered for deriving basic earnings per share and the weighted average number of equity shares which been issued on the conversion of all dilutive potential equity shares. Potential equity shares are deemed to be dilutive only if their conversion to equity shares would decrease the net profit per share from continuing ordinary operations. Potential dilutive equity shares are deemed to be converted as at the beginning of the period, unless they have been issued at a later date. The dilutive potential equity shares are adjusted for the proceeds receivable had the shares been actually issued at fair value (i.e. average market value of the outstanding shares). The number of equity shares and potentially dilutive equity shares are adjusted for share splits and bonus shares, if any, as appropriate.

(1.12) Cash and cash equivalents (for the purpose of Cash Flow Statement)

Cash comprises of cash in hand and demand deposits with banks. Cash equivalents are short term balance.
